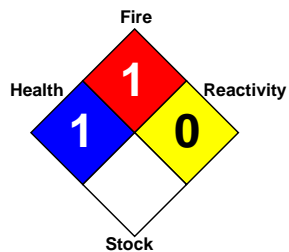

Eye Contact
